ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Torhouse Stone Circle comprises a stone circle of prehistoric date. The monument lies at around 130m OD, and comprises nineteen granite boulders, set in a circle with a diameter of about 22m and ranging from about 0.6m to about 1.5m in height. The boulders which are set on a slightly raised platform, are largest at the SE of the circle. The area to be scheduled comprises the remains described and an area around them within which related material may be expected to be found. It is sub-rectangular with maximum dimensions of 63m from NE-SW and 59m from NW-SE, bounded on all sides by a fence. The fence and gate are excluded from the scheduling. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Wigtown and the County of Wigtown as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto [REDACTED]

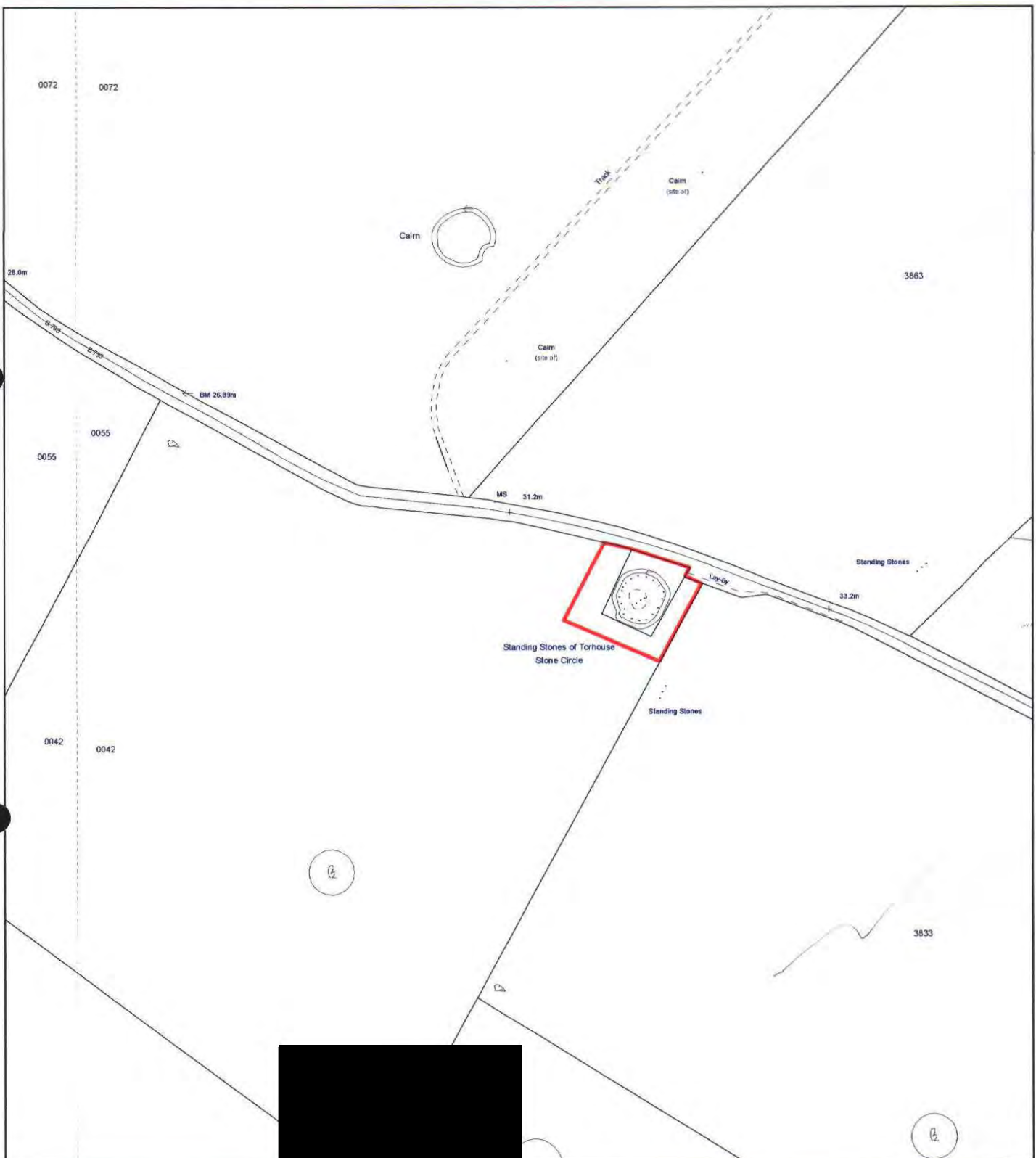
