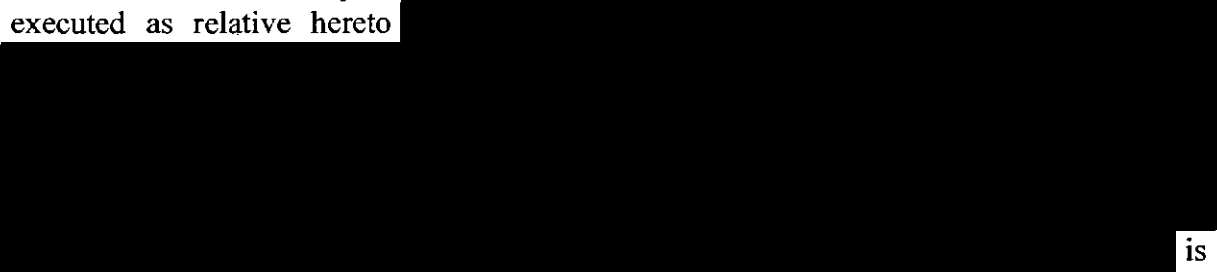

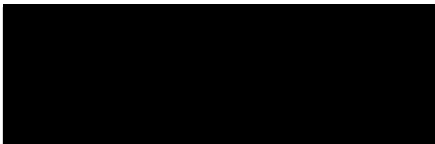

ENTRY IN THE SCHEDULE OF MONUMENTS

The monument known as Cadzow Castle comprises the remains of a late medieval castle, which survives as substantial stone structures, earthworks and buried archaeology, together with an area enclosing the outer defences. The area to be scheduled comprises the remains described and an area around them within which related material may be expected to be found. It is irregular with maximum dimensions of 109m N-S by 186m E-W. The modern fences are excluded from the scheduling, as is the upper 300mm surface of all modern roads and paths, to allow for their maintenance. The monument, which lies in the Parish of Hamilton and the County of Lanark as shown outlined in red on the Plan annexed and executed as relative hereto

 is hereby included in the Schedule of Monuments appearing to the Scottish Ministers to be of national importance compiled and maintained by them under section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979.

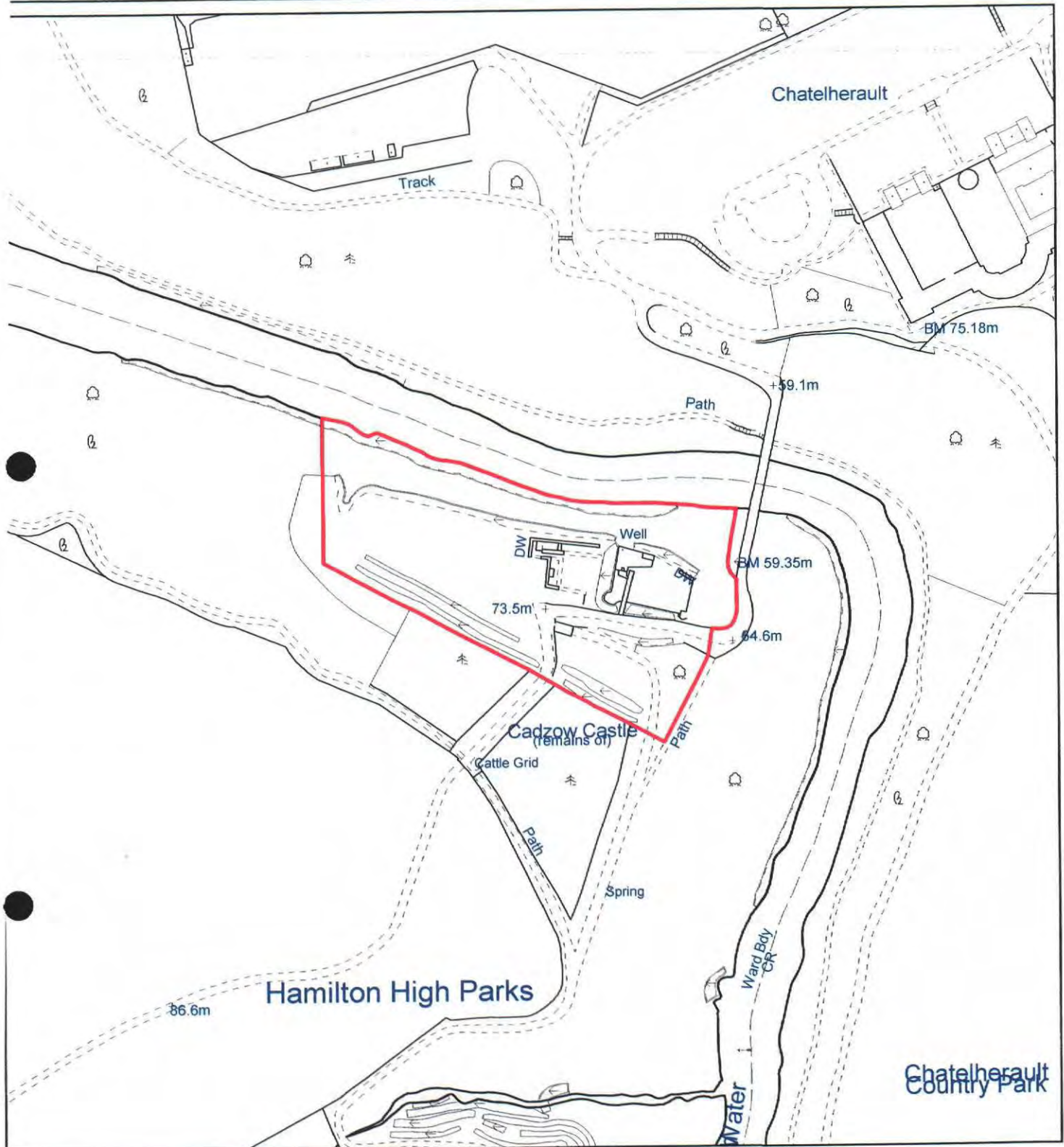
