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### 5 Description of proposed works

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Young regenerating sycamores growing within and close to the chapel will be felled sectionally. They will be felled onto other neighbouring trees to avoid any impact damage on the ground or upstanding remains. The timber will be cut into lengths and stacked away from any visible remains and within the scheduled area, avoiding any areas where rabbits are active. This will be carried out in the autumn of 2016. Scrubby elder will also be cut down. Stumps will be left in situ and any regeneration will be treated in subsequent years.</li></ul>
