<b>5 Description of proposed works</b>
<p>The existing gates are severely rusted and have come to the end of their useful life and therefore require replacement. The proposed work is to install a new set of gates that provide the security the yard requires, i.e. match the height of the lower of the two adjacent walls.</p> <p>The archaeological sensitivity of this location is largely unknown, although it is likely that the locations of the excavations for the required new gate posts have been previously disturbed during installation of the existing gate posts and the building of the adjacent walls. The works will be archaeologically</p>

monitored under the terms of the PIC call-off contract.
