Dismount steel yetts to ground floor and make demountable, blast clean and redecorate

**5 Description of proposed works**

Ground and stair landing yetts are corroding and causing damage to stone. These are made of mild steel (Ministry of Works works c. 1950-70 attributed by the material and detailing of the yett knots) and require blast cleaning and redecoating under workshop conditions to stand against the salt laden air.

Proposed works: Cut out steel yetts and alter bar ends to form lap joints to facilitate future dismounting for maintenance. Blast clean, redecorate and refit new lexan with stainless steel mesh central vent held in SS frame bolted to Lexan.
