Insert metal post and safety grille to curtain wall to support masonry.  
Screen off oven to prevent access (interior unstable).  
Erect temporary support to fireplace lintel whilst routine repointing of cantilevering stones and flue interior (a balloon will be inserted to provide safe working zone below for masons to safely repoint. A stainless steel net will then be fitted to the flue to catch any loose stones from the area above which cannot be reached.  
Lime mortar to be used throughout, metal fixings into mortar joints only.
