4 Summary of proposed works (max 20 words)

Rebuild 3m length of the drystone boundary wall on a like-for-like basis, and restring the two strands of galvanised iron wire using existing iron posts.

5 Description of proposed works

Using the materials which formed the original drystone wall, rebuild it so it exactly matches the wall on either side. The wall is 0.75m wide at base, tapering upwards to 0.45m, with a course of larger rocks along the top. The length of wall affected is 2.6m at the top, and the wall is 1.1m high. In the collapse, an iron fence post has come down: this is in reasonable condition, so it will be reinstated on the wall. In addition, the two strands of galvanised iron wire which run all round the graveyard will be replaced with new wire, using the existing iron posts.
