### 4 Summary of proposed works (max 20 words)

Replace a loose stone, which has rolled out from the artificial mound. Replace 'curtain' iron railings with replica iron railing. Clean biological growth off surface of cross and fill open fracture with sacrificial acrylic mortar.

### 5 Description of proposed works

Work to the artificial mound (into which the Cross is set): replace a large loose stone, which has rolled out from the Cross' artificial mound, by infilling using the existing stone, if possible, if not using matching smaller stones.



Large stone fallen and rolled-out into railings, causing damage to railings.



Large stone previously set into the mound 'end-in'.

Work to the railings: replace the corroded railings around the cross with iron replica, black powder coated. The new railings are 3m square. Seen below, upside down and before powder coating. The railings are made in four sections with fixing posts. They are tapered at ground level to follow the lie of the land.



Work to the Cross: the biological growth will be carefully removed using medium natural or nylon bristle brushes and clean tap water whilst taking care to monitor the surface of the stone to avoid damage. The open fractures on the north side will be filled with a sacrificial acrylic mortar. Work will be carried out under the supervision of an accredited conservator from practice: [REDACTED]
