installation of six tubular steel piles for 24m floating pontoon to attach to and sediment management for pontoon to float

5 Description of proposed works

Works to be carried out - Installation of six tubular steel piles into the canal bed approx 2m. Sediment management to allow the pontoon to float close to the bank, the sediment management will be small and localised to each floats effected by localised shallow draft at certain areas around a third of the length of the pontoon. Machine to be used is still to be confirmed but will probably be 25t to allow for the required reach. Bog matting will be deployed to protect the embankment from any damage from the machine tracks. Works to be carried out in dry weather conditions or additional matting will be used. The six piles will be driven by a piling hammer directly into the water's edge.
