The Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979

Amended entry in the schedule of monuments

Historic Environment Scotland in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979 hereby amends the entry in the statutory schedule of monuments as set out below.

The monument known as **Pittarhie Castle** comprises a late medieval/early modern tower house with the remains of a range of buildings about 30m to the north and a former walled garden and group of garden terraces to the south and southwest. The tower house is visible as a standing building with a modified L-plan, the ancillary buildings and walled garden as stone wall foundations, and the terraces as earthworks. The monument is located on a gentle south-facing slope about 150m above sea level.

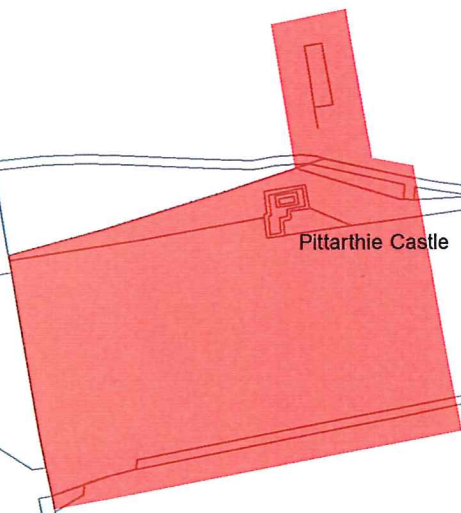
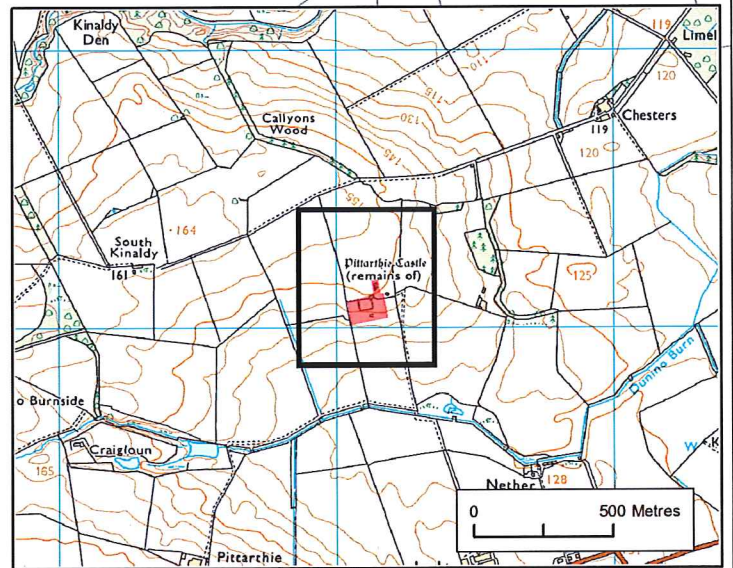
The scheduled area is irregular in plan, to include the remains described above and an area around them within which evidence relating to the monument's construction, use and abandonment is expected to survive. The scheduling extends up to but does not include the post-and-wire fence to the north and west and excludes the above-ground elements of all other post-and-wire fences

The monument, which lies in the Parish of Dunino and the County of Fife as shown in red on the plan annexed and executed as relative hereto.

This entry supersedes the Entry in the Schedule of Monuments for the monument known then as **Pittarhie Castle** as referred to in the Entry in the Schedule of Monuments by the Scottish Ministers in respect of the monument dated 29 October 2003 and recorded in the General Register of Sasines for the County of Fife on 19 November 2003.
