Historic Environment Scotland hereby **grants** scheduled monument consent for the works detailed below without conditions.

Consented Works:

- a) Erect six pedestrian and cycle counters along the towpath of the stretch of the Caledonian Canal running from Banavie to Inverness

as described in your application dated 08 August and the following supporting documents:

- 1) Survey sheets describing the location and character of each site for the proposed counters. One supplied for each site.
- 2) Sketch drawing of design for plinths to be fitted within towpaths.
- 3) Sketch drawing of design for cabinet plinths
- 4) Methodology document for installation of pinth

Reasons for the Decision

The works proposed are considered acceptable in meeting the terms of national policy for scheduled monuments, and also accounting for other material considerations.
