Stabilisation of ashlar masonry retaining wall and installation of additional safety railing

5 Description of proposed works

There are 2 elements of works to be undertaken -

- Handrail installation – to ensure public safety the handrail that is currently in place around the viewpoint will be extended by 10m once the wall refurbishment works have been completed. Specification will match existing.
- Outer harbour wall repairs – The wall is in a poor condition and continued deterioration in conjunction with erosion from the nearby River Clyde – which is tidal at this location – would result in failure. The wall protects the neighbouring basin and the repairs will ensure the

existing fabric is retained. The proposed works involve pointing, grouting, underpinning and sectional reconstruction to stabilise the existing structure. Rip rap stone will be placed at the base of the wall to protect against wave erosion
