Crinan Canal installation of LED solar towpath lights following hard towpath upgrade.

5 Description of proposed works

NGR Start location E185238 N685261 & NGR Finish location E185609 N687923 .Towpath solar led lights have been installed in Glasgow, Edinburgh and Falkirk over many years. It is proposed to install the same specification of towpath lights as used at the other locations using the same methodology and materials. The lights are installed directly into the new upgrade, hard towpath and are no greater in depth than 50mm same depth as the new hard towpath surface. The light colour is white and will be installed at 7 metre centres on the edge of the towpath, both sides and directly opposite each other.
