1. Decision

The monument was first scheduled in 2011. To ensure that the boundary of the scheduled monument encompasses all known archaeological remains of national importance, the decision is to amend the entry in the Schedule as **Garlieston, Mulberry harbour remains 2070m ENE, 1035m E and 1860m S of.**

2. Designation Background and Development Proposals

2.1 Designation Background

The monument was first scheduled in 2011; there have been no amendments prior to this assessment.

3. Assessment

3.1 Assessment information

In February 2016, the Archaeologist for Dumfries and Galloway Council contacted Historic Environment Scotland with information that the northeast portion of the scheduled area was located slightly to the south of the actual remains as shown on recent aerial photographs and maps of the area.

The site was visited on 21/03/2016 at the time of low water in order to confirm the location of the site and to check the number of pontoons visible. This confirmed a positional error in the original 2011 scheduling map for the northeast portion of the monument of circa 45m (too far to the south). The low level of the tide resulted in identification of a fifth concrete pontoon which had not been seen during the initial assessment in 2011.

This scheduling amendment is required to correct the location of the northeast portion of the monument and to refer to the fifth concrete pontoon.

3.2 Assessment against designation criteria

An assessment against the scheduling criteria has not been carried out. The monument was first scheduled in 2011 and was found to meet the criteria for scheduling. No information has arisen since 2011 to indicate the site may not meet the criteria now or requires a full re-assessment. Additional associated remains in the form of another concrete pontoon have been recorded and can now be included in the scheduling.
