manufacture : the seat slats in 6mm mild steel and the designs to be incorporated would be laser cut out as per agreed design. The ends would be manufactured from 60mm x 5mm diameter tube. The bench would be fully hot dipped galvanised and wet spray finished in any RAL or BS colour required.

Seat Size: 1500mm (3 seater)
