Historic Environment Scotland hereby **grants** section 42 consent for the works detailed below, subject to the attached condition.

Consented Works:

- a) Archaeological geophysical survey comprising Magnetometry and Ground Penetrating Radar (GPR).

- 1) Geo-physical method statement for Islay Heritage, Project 2 *Islesman*
- 2) Kildalton Cross and Chapel, Isle of Islay, Islay Heritage 2: a project of discovery, research, conservation and writing.

1. No works requiring Section 42 consent shall commence on site until a statement containing details of the geophysical surveyor doing the work, and arrangements for reporting and archiving, has been approved in writing by Historic Environment Scotland.
