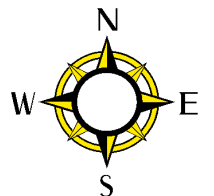


MAP for wo 3032 - Cramond Kirk grounds

CR Crown Reduction (specify ht/spr in comments section) 1 tree

Tree marked with white spot at base.

Crown reduce x2 stems NE aspect by approx 5m in height, reducing any remaining lateral spread by 1-2m.

Crown reduce the rest of the upper canopy by 2-3m in height, again reducing lateral spread by 1-2m to rebalance.

Crown reduction to alleviate wind loading on compression fork union between 40cm and 1.2m from ground level.

Report that tree had split at union but no obvious crack indicating union has been compromised.

On north aspect of trunk between 40cm and 80cm there is a damp area around base of com fork but no clear crack apparent.

On north aspect of trunk between 80cm and 1.2m com fork appears solid, no gap visible between occluding bark.

South aspect of stem union fully occluded, no evidence of any recent splitting.

Small accumulation of dirt in centre of fork, probing with podger vertically downward finds solid wood at depth of approx 50mm.

Extensive damage to surface of structural roots from grass cutters.

Photograph of compression fork taken.
Reinspect 1year.
