Dryburgh Abbey, remedial works to 10 memorials

Please find below specification and quotation for the following works to 10 memorials.

Types of memorials

10 memorials in sandstone or granite, construction comprising of base and plate, plus Monolith type memorials.

Faults in memorials

- 1/ loose on foundations
- 2/ loose and moving between joints
- 3/ Lying at an angle deemed unsafe

Works required

Carefully mechanical lift 9 memorials from existing foundations and lay flat, excavate and lay foundations. Anchor pin and cement bed memorials to new foundations

Hood memorial:- Drill and re pin plate to existing base

Specification of materials

Concrete ballast mix for foundation
Stainless steel threaded anchor pins, 16mm, 18mm and 25mm pending size of memorial fixed with memfix resin.
Joints bedded in pure cement or lime mortar
Remove surplus foundation bricks and from Abbey
