### 4 Summary of proposed works (max 20 words)

Installation of a new pre-cast concrete edge to match that previously installed further around the bay.
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### 5 Description of proposed works

The failure of the existing concrete edging (stacked concrete bags) had let water from the loch through to undermine the adjacent footpath, causing subsidence of parts of the path. This had resulted in an uneven surface to the footpath and one instance of a pedestrian tripping and falling into the Loch. WLC requested we carry out repairs to the edge as a matter of urgency to allow them to resurface the path. This work was carried out under Class 5 consent but the accompanying new
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concrete edging was not installed as part of Phase 1 works due to cost restraints. (The Phase 1 works limited themselves to repairs to the vertical retaining wall and a temporary edging was put in place to allow the resurfacing of the path to proceed).

We are therefore now applying for consent to complete the works by installation of the new concrete edging that is designed to match that previously installed further along the footpath. This work will involve removal of the temporary edging that was installed under Phase 1 works to allow WLC to resurface the path, and installation of the new pre-cast concrete edging in its place (see accompanying drawing for details).
