The Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979

Amended entry in the schedule of monuments

Historic Environment Scotland in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979 hereby amends the entry in the statutory schedule of monuments as set out below.

The monument known as **Fearnoch, chapel, enclosure and holy well 400m E of** comprises the remains of a chapel site probably dating to the Early Christian period. The chapel is rectangular and survives as low turf-covered walls, surrounded by sub-rectangular enclosure. There is a break in the south wall of the enclosure from which a track leads to a well downslope. The monument is situated at about 120m above sea level on a small rise with views across the Kyles of Bute.

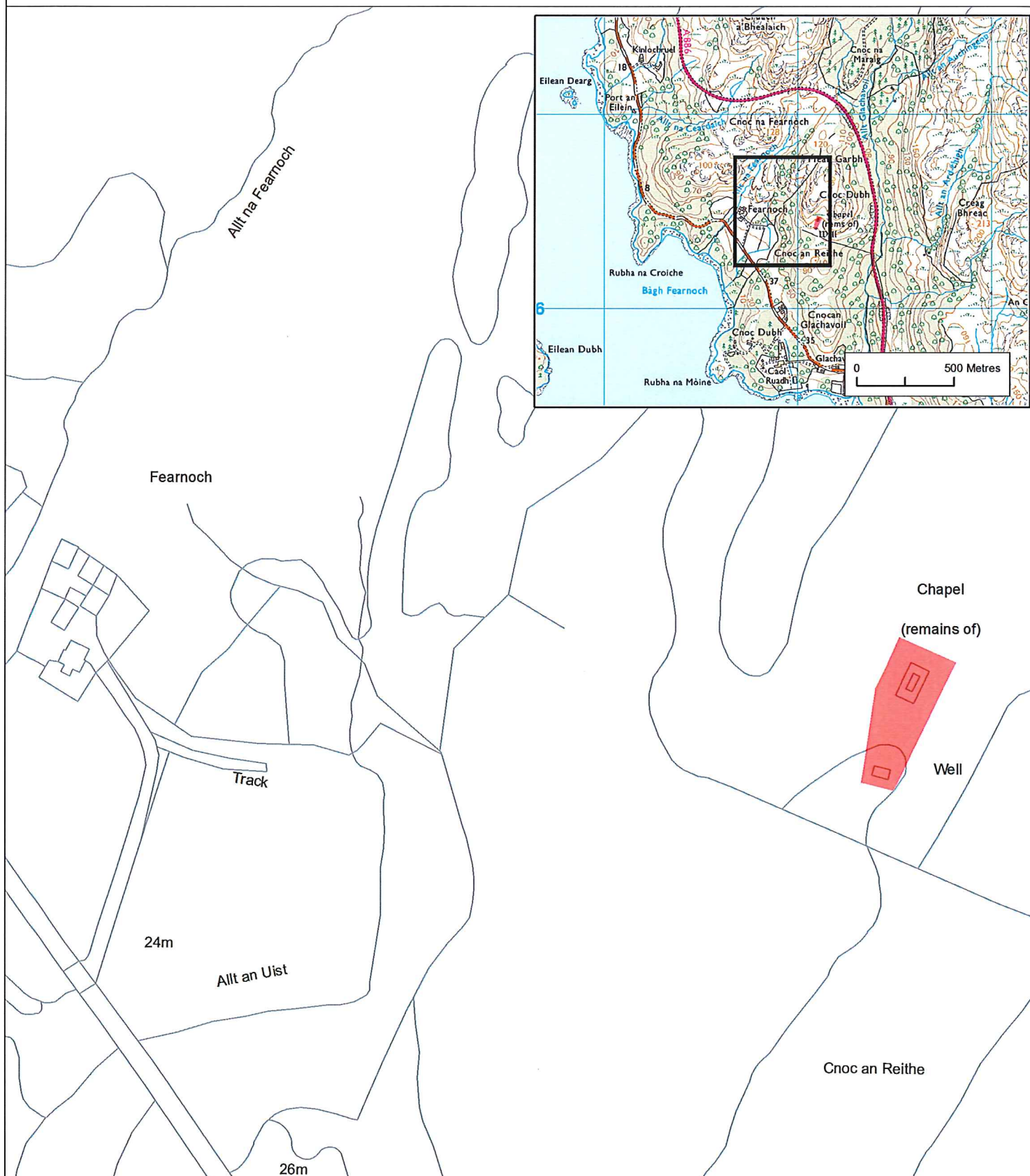
The scheduled area is irregular on plan to include the remains of both the chapel and enclosure and the well described above and an area around in which evidence for the monuments construction, use and abandonment is expected to survive

The monument, which lies in the Parish of Inverchaolain and the County of Argyll as shown in red on the plan annexed and executed as relative hereto.

This entry supersedes the Entry in the Schedule of Monuments for the monument known then as **Fearnach Chapel (in ruins) and Enclosure** as referred to in the Certificate of Service of Notice by the Secretary of State for Scotland in respect of the monument dated 26 July 1972 and recorded in the General Register of Sasines for the County of Argyll on 14 August 1972.

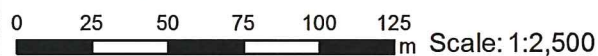
Fearnoch, chapel, enclosure and holy well 400m E of
