We need your permission to install and maintain our equipment on your property at:

We need this equipment to be able to connect your tenant. We can't provide them with service until we install:

If, in the future, you decide to improve your land, meaning that our equipment would need to be moved or altered, you will be able to give us notice to move in writing (in accordance with paragraph 20 of the Electronic Communications Code). We would be happy to comply with any such request as long as there's a suitable alternative position for the equipment. We won't refuse your request unreasonably.

I'd be grateful if you could sign the agreement and print your name in the space provided for the grantor on page one (*for applications in Scotland please also complete the witness details*). Please don't date the agreement. Please then send back one

Just to point out that we need your agreement as soon as possible, because unfortunately we can't provide service to your tenant without it.

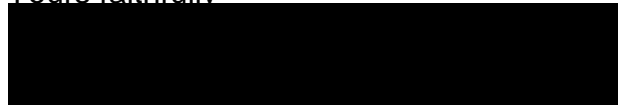
Once I've received your consent, then we'll have the necessary permissions to proceed and we will complete the agreement.

As this installation is to provide services to your tenant, we cannot cover any professional fees you may incur, for example, surveyors' fees to assess the route of the equipment.
