**4 Summary of proposed works (max 20 words)**

Governor's House Raking out cementitious mortar and repoint remaining areas of coursed random rubble on rear elevation.

**5 Description of proposed works**

Masonry- Carefully consolidate elevation by raking out joints to remove cracked and decayed cementitious mortar and boss lime powdering mortar and tamping and repointing all wall faces with lime mortar. Cementitious and degraded lime mortar to be removed from joints, leave any sound lime mortar attached to masonry. Indent badly cracked and decayed rubble stones as necessary. Mortar mix for consolidation and pointing of rubble: 1 lime 2 sand (by weight) of Otterbien 212 NHL2 lime mortar, sands Cambusmore Quarry gauging with pre added fer) admix air entrainer. Indenting decayed small sandstone pinnings and stones in rubble masonry in geologically matching red & buff

sandstone e.g. Locherbrigg. Quarry, Dumfries for red and Culallo Quarry Fife, profiled and tooled to exactly match decayed original.

Windows- To repair the window by replacing the half cills with a hardwood cills meeting rails etc. run to exactly the same profile, similarly repair decayed window stiles. Timberwork to be fully prepared and redecorated in high specification paint system after works complete.
