Proposed Works	Installation of non-groundfast perimeter fencing, surface electrical connection, access ramp and reopen former gateway in dyke for visitor access		

Historic Environment Scotland hereby **grants** scheduled monument consent for the works detailed below without conditions.

Consented Works:

- a) Construct an access ramp using a corduroy track, from a gap in the stone dyke dividing the upper and lower parts of the Glebe Field, to link up with the porch area of the roundhouse.
- b) Sweeten the relatively steep profile of the earthen revetting for the concrete slab on which the roundhouse sits. This would involve adding further soil to the edge from the remains of the small spoilheap.
