Historic Environment Scotland hereby **grants** scheduled monument consent for the works detailed below without conditions.

Consented Works:

- a) drilling 20mm cores into the base of the cross and the coping of the socket stone, to a total depth of 160mm
- b) drilling a 20mm core into the masonry of the bellcote
- c) inserting a 680mm long stainless steel rod of 16mm diameter into the drilled holes, so that the cross, socket stone and bellcote are secured
- d) related pointing works

as described in your application which we validated on 31 October 2016 and the following supporting documents:
