Installation of railings to truncated forework tower within the Queen Anne Gardens

**5 Description of proposed works**

To address known risks of falls from height onto a hard standings, a new set of railings are proposed to provide the necessary edge protection to the truncated tower. Railings are to be traditionally made and based on an existing design on the site. Railings will be fixed into mortar joints and small support pad foundations are required to provide support to the railings. An archaeological watching brief will be provided when excavating for the pad foundation, upon agreement of a written scheme of investigation. Refer to archeological assessment submitted as part of this application.
