Within Mill Garden: tree removal, road edge reformation and reinforcement, hedge replanting

5 Description of proposed works

Within Mill Garden adjacent to west of Mill, depositing material to reprofile garden ground up to road, excavating and forming concrete foundations, reforming verge to line slightly set back into garden area and extending road surface a little to abut, installing granite boulders beside road edge, grubbing out and replanting part of roadside hedge to slightly different alignment, cherry tree removal.

Separate Planning Permission and Works to Protected Tree applications have been submitted for these works to Dumfries and Galloway Council. The Dumfries and Galloway Archaeologist has also been informed of proposals.

Our Natural Environment Advisor reports that otters, an EPS, have been recorded at the nearby New Abbey Pow burn but no holts are evident within 50m at present and though close to the burn, the site is in a village beside a main A road making otter visits less likely. His suggested precautionary mitigation measures - instructing site operations personnel to avoid disturbing any otters in the area by avoiding entering water courses and basic site fencing to discourage any otters from entering the work area when any open excavations exist and the site is unattended would be adopted.
