Historic Environment Scotland hereby **grants** scheduled monument consent for the works detailed below, subject to the attached condition.

Consented Works:

The proposals comprise:

- Raking out cementitious mortar on the Governor's House rear (north) elevation.
- Repointing with lime mortar.
- Indenting decayed sandstone rubble where required.
- Repairing timber at windows where required.

as described in your application which we validated on 06 December 2016 and the following supporting documents:

- North Elevation Proposals Drawing 193-107-536

Conditions referred to above

1. No indenting shall take place until the extent has been agreed in writing beforehand by Historic Environment Scotland's Heritage Directorate.

To ensure that any impacts on historic fabric is minimized and that an accurate record of changes to the monument is maintained.

Reasons for the Decision:

Subject to compliance with the schedule of conditions, the works proposed are considered acceptable in meeting the terms of national policy for scheduled monuments, and also accounting for other material considerations.
