### The Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979

#### Amended entry in the schedule of monuments

Historic Environment Scotland in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979 hereby amends the entry in the statutory schedule of monuments as set out below.

The monument known as **Scotsburn House, chambered cairn 400m NNW of Scotsburn Bridge** comprises the remains of a chambered cairn dating from the Neolithic period to early Bronze Age (between 3800 and 2500 BC) and is visible as a mound of earth measuring approximately 12m in diameter with large projecting stones. The monument is located on a knoll, 135m east of Balnagown River, at around 125m above sea level.

The scheduled area is circular on plan, measuring 37m in diameter and centred on the monument. The scheduling includes the remains described above and an area around them within which evidence relating to the monument's construction, use and abandonment is expected to survive.

The monument, which lies in the Parish of Logie Easter and the County of Ross and Cromarty as shown in red on the plan annexed and executed as relative hereto.

This entry supersedes the Entry in the Schedule of Monuments for the monument known then as **Scotsburn House, chambered cairn 520m W of** as referred to in the Certificate of Service of Notice by the Secretary of State for Scotland in respect of the monument dated 1 December 1975 and recorded in the General Register of Sasines for the County of Ross and Cromarty on 16 December 1975.
