The Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979

Amended entry in the schedule of monuments

Historic Environment Scotland in exercise of the powers conferred on it by section 1(1) of the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Areas Act 1979 hereby amends the entry in the statutory schedule of monuments as set out below.

The monument known as **Creag Evanachan, cairn** comprises a cairn dating to the Bronze Age (between about 2000 BC and 800 BC). It is visible as a circular mound of stones measuring approximately 20m in diameter and standing up to 2m high. The monument is situated close to the summit of Creag Evanachan at 195m above sea level

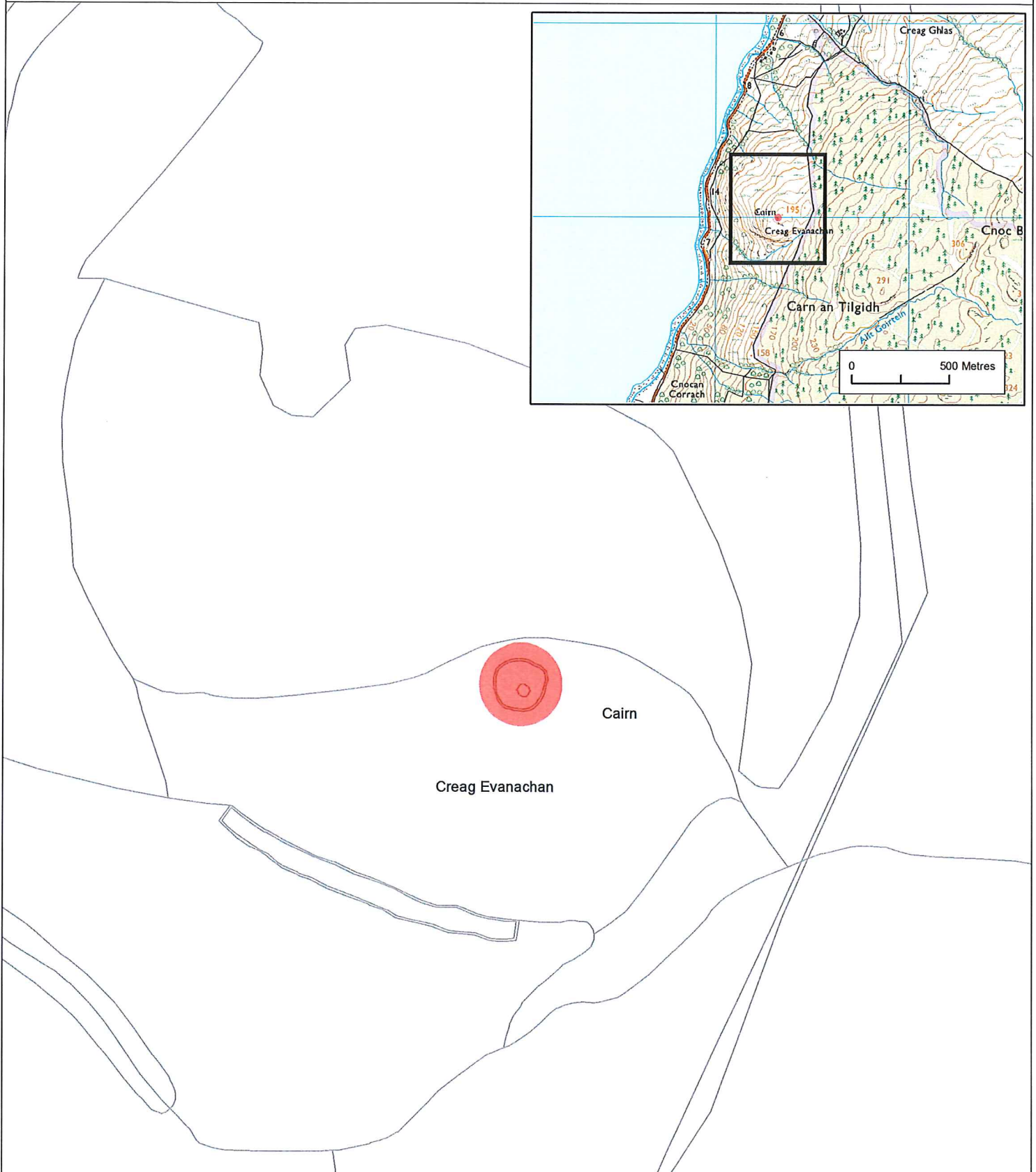
The scheduled area is circular on plan measuring 40m in diameter to include the remains described above and an area around them within which evidence relating to the monument's construction, use and abandonment is expected to survive.

The monument, which lies in the Parish of Strathlachlan and the County of Argyll as shown in red on the plan annexed and executed as relative hereto.

This entry supersedes the Entry in the Schedule of Monuments for the monument known then as **Creag Evanachan Cairn, 540m NW of Carn an Tilgidh** as referred to in the Certificate of Service of Notice by the Secretary of State for Scotland in respect of the monument dated 13th August 1974 and recorded in the General Register of Sasines for the County of Argyll on 4th September 1974.
