



New Fence:
 Round posts every 10ft with strainer post every 100yds. Wire fitted to inside (south side) top and 4-6 ins above ground onto which 18 gauge good quality rabbit proof fence attached extending 3ft high and a flap extending 12-18ins along ground on outer side. Offset electric wire to outside of fence.

* Post holes on these two sides to be pre-dug by archaeologists prior to posts being driven into ground by fencing contractor.
