Proposed Works	Within Mill Garden: tree removal, road edge reformation and reinforcement, hedge replanting		

Historic Environment Scotland hereby **grants** scheduled monument consent for the works detailed below without conditions.

Consented Works:

- a) The removal of a damaged cherry tree within the Mill Garden;
- b) Grubbing out and replanting of the hedge to a slightly different alignment;
- c) The deposition of material in order to re-profile ground within the garden up to the road;
- d) Reforming the line of the verge to be set further back into the garden and extending road surface a little to abut;
- e) Installation of granite boulders beside the road edge; and
- f) Excavation of ground to create concrete foundations for the boulders.

- 1) Photographs of the current condition of the hedge, roadside and general development area
- 2) Cross-section plan of the existing road section
- 3) Detailed cross-section plan of the proposed development
- 4) Proposed Archaeological Mitigation plan
