Condense pipes taken down from Gallery through new 25mm dia. hole in floorboards; then through existing hole in horizontal beam above timber panelling on west face of Lobby, and into store off the passage between Great Hall and Queen Anne Kitchen. Pipes to be routed over doorway and along wall and taken down to an existing 250mm sq. aperture giving access to the solum of the QA Kitchen. No fixings into historic fabric.

THE GREAT HALL

Condense pipes taken through existing aperture in west wall of passage into solum below kitchen, then through new kitchen floor and to a convenient discharge point at one of the existing sinks. Wall aperture (approx 250mm sq.) to be packed with rockwool on completion.
